

TEEN-PARENT COUNTERMEASURE FOR TEEN RISKY DRIVING

Help us to better understand teen driving behavior!

The purpose of the study is to evaluate resources designed to help teens and parents improve teen driving safety.

Parent and teen participants will complete surveys about driving, download and use a driving app, and teens will drive for 4-weeks using their vehicle's Intelligent Speed Assist (ISA) system / speeding alerts.

Does your teen drive a vehicle equipped with Intelligent Speed Assist (ISA) / speeding alerts?

You and your teen may be eligible to participate

Participants (parent and teen) will be asked to attend three virtual appointments (30-,45-, & 45-minutes), download/use a driving app, and teens will be asked to drive for 4-weeks

Parents will receive up to \$75 and teens will receive up to \$125
